Make sure to review with your children over the summer, so they don't forget their multiplication, division, and fraction skills. They are expected to have mastered these basic skills by the time they reach 5th grade Math.

5th Grade Math Packet (4th graders going into 5th grade)

1. Write Multiplication Tables three times each (3's through 12's)
2. Measure 5 objects. Measure them in inches, feet, and yards.
3. Measure 5 objects. Measure them in mm, cm, and meters.
4. Make a design with as many of the following as you can; square, circle, triangle, rectangle, pentagon, hexagon, octagon. Color your design.
5. Write 4 word problems; 2 using multiplication and 2 using decimals. Work out your problems and show your work.
6. Write 4 word problems; 2 using fractions and 2 using decimals. Work out your problems and show your work.
7. Make up a recipe or copy one of your mother's favorite recipes. Double the recipe and show how you got your answers. Then triple it!
8. Draw a picture or design than show that an object or objects are symmetrical. Color your picture or design.

Have your parents initial each task on this sheet as you complete it. Your work should be turned in with this task sheet and given to Mrs. Yore on the first day of school. This will be a grade in Math.
