Greetings Parents of Sacred Heart Catholic School,

It seems that most sentences start with “during this time” or “in these unforeseen circumstances” regarding our current year 2020. Your Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) is no different. The 2020-2021 PTO Board has been given the task of fundraising in an environment that is financially difficult for families and social gatherings are discouraged. But the need for fundraising does not go away. Our school depends on the PTO to provide a financial gift yearly.

When things are different “during this time” we must think outside the box. Try things that have never been done before – which is how your PTO Board came up with the idea to sell Frontier Trash Bags. Think “Clean Out 2020”!

Frontier Trash Bags come in three sizes – regular kitchen bags and two sizes of construction grade bags. These are great for your personal use and for businesses. Bags sell for \$12.00 a roll. Each student is encouraged to sell 10 rolls which equals \$120.00. If you do not need the actual trash bags – an option is to donate the bags back to the school.

This is the ONE and ONLY fundraiser this year. It is organized to be a family fundraiser. Parents will receive one service hour per roll sold. In case you are not aware, families are required to volunteer at the school for either 15 hours or 30 hours. Selling bags can help you as a parent reach your service hour goals.

“Clean Out 2020” will begin on January 7 and end January 21st. It is a TWO-WEEK sale. Frontier provides a website for online ordering. This will help our students and parents sell safely. The bags will be delivered to Sacred Heart Catholic School’s Elementary parking lot a week after the sale. On delivery day, parents will need to pick up the bags their family sold and distribute those bags to their customers.
