ACTIVITY

Weeks 1-2:

1. Watch YouTube Freeschool video *Castles*. Look at images of castles and remains of castles from the Middle Ages.
2. Draw your own castle based on the pictures and using your imagination. Trace in sharpie and add color using crayons, colored pencil, and/or watercolor paint.

Weeks 3-4:

1. Create a guided linear drawing of a king/queen using black tempera paint. Allow to fully dry.
2. Add color using tempera paint.

Weeks 5-6:

1. Discuss the history of knights in Medieval times. Look at drawings and paintings of knights.
2. Draw a knight in pencil. Using glue and scissors, add materials such as paper, aluminum foil, and anything you like to your knight to create an interesting collage
