

## 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade Dress Code 2019-2020

Sacred Heart Catholic School students wear uniforms to provide a sense of pride and respect. Uniforms downplay materialism and eliminate problems associated with inappropriate attire in the academic setting. Much effort has been put into the decision-making process regarding the dress code, and parents are urged to review the entire dress code prior to purchasing any items.

By agreeing to be a Sacred Heart student, it is inherently agreed that families will follow the school's dress code policy. **All uniform clothing items must in the style specified by the school and be purchased from school-authorized retailers listed in the dress code. Shoes and accessories may be purchased from any retailer. Non-compliance with the dress code will result in disciplinary action, including a phone call to parents to deliver appropriate apparel. THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATION HAS THE RIGHT TO AMEND ANY PART OF THIS DRESS CODE.**

- Whenever students are dressed in the school uniform, it is expected that they represent the school in a positive way. Students are asked to adhere to the entire dress code when dressed in any portion of the uniform, regardless of whether or not on campus. This includes jewelry and other accessories.
- New monogrammed items must be purchased and monogrammed by Lands' End or Scrubs and More. Unlawful use of the school logo is prohibited. Items monogrammed by other vendors may not be worn.
- Out of uniform days must be approved by Administration and must be on the school calendar.
- **Parents will be required to replace uniform items within 5 days of notification of poor condition, improper fit or improper style.**

# 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Uniform Requirements and Dress Code Rules

**Mass Uniform:** Clothing and shoes listed in bold are required items for the Mass uniform. These items may be worn on any school day but are required on Mass days.

<b>Polo</b>	Navy blue long or short sleeve uniform polo with school logo. May wear untucked.	Navy blue long or short sleeve uniform polo with school logo. Must be worn tucked.
<b>Blouse/Shirt</b>	<b>Long or short sleeve white school uniform blouse.</b> May wear untucked.	<b>White oxford, long or short sleeve, button-down shirt.</b> Must be worn tucked.
<b>Skirt/Pants</b>	<b>Plaid uniform skirt</b> hemmed 2" from the top of the knee when standing; worn with shorts underneath.	<b>Khaki uniform pants</b> or shorts.
<b>Crosstie/Tie</b>	<b>Plaid uniform crosstie.</b>	<b>Plaid uniform long tie.</b>
<b>Belt</b>		<b>Solid black or brown belt.</b>
<b>Socks/Tights</b>	White or black crew length socks with tennis shoes; <b>Navy socks with uniform saddle oxfords;</b> Navy tights/leggings during cold weather.	White or black crew length socks with shorts; <b>Dark or tan socks with pants.</b>
<b>Shoes</b>	Any gray tennis shoe, with accent colors of white or black only; No high-tops. <b>Black and white uniform saddle oxfords.</b>	Any gray tennis shoe, with accent colors of white or black only; No high-tops. <b>Men's brown/tan boat style shoe with laces &amp; visible sole (i.e. Sperry).</b>
<b>Outerwear (Optional for Mass)</b>	<b>School sweatshirt (sold at school); Uniform sweater/vest; Uniform jacket</b> or letter jacket; School-approved spirit wear sweatshirts and jackets.	<b>School sweatshirt (sold at school); Uniform sweater/vest; Uniform jacket</b> or letter jacket. School-approved spirit wear sweatshirts and jackets.
<b>Jewelry</b>	Limited to one earring per ear, worn in the lobe only; no hoops allowed; religious necklace; up to 3 casual bracelets. No other piercings.	Religious necklaces only; No earrings or other piercings.
<b>Hair/Grooming</b>	No extreme hair color/extensions; Hair accessories to match uniform; no visible tattoos or body piercings; Makeup in moderation; muted nail colors.	Must be clean-shaven; hair should not touch collar or hang in eyes; no shaggy hairstyles or ponytails; no visible tattoos or body piercings.
<b>Game Day Attire (Athletes)</b>	Official game day shirt & uniform skirt. (Ordering information will be given through team communication.)	Official game day shirt & uniform shorts or pants. (Ordering information will be given through team communication.)
<b>T-Shirt Days (As Scheduled)</b>	Any appropriate t-shirt and jeans with no holes or uniform skirt; No flip-flop shoes. T-Shirt Days will be listed on the school calendar with specific themes (Spirit Day, 5K, Mardi Gras, etc.)	Any appropriate t-shirt and jeans with no holes or uniform shorts/pants; No flip-flop shoes. T-Shirt Days will be listed on the school calendar with specific themes (Spirit Day, 5K, Mardi Gras, etc.)
