

## Sacred Heart High School Return to School Plans 2021-2022 – FAQs

### Arrival & Dismissal

- Pick-up and drop-off routes will remain the same.
- Students will enter from the parking lot through the center entrance
- Students will be dismissed at 3 p.m. using the rear parking lot doors.

#### Morning Schedule:

7 a.m.	Cafeteria open for breakfast and snack purchases.
7 a.m.-7:50 a.m.	Students will remain in the cafeteria and downstairs main hallway.
7:50 a.m.- 8 a.m.	Students will be released from downstairs and teachers will be on duty.
8 a.m.	All students should be in the first class of the day. Late arrivals must go to the office to sign-in.

### School-Day

- Locker rooms will not be used as we are moving towards classroom sets of books only with each student downloading textbooks to their devices.
- Snacks will be available to be purchased during break time in the cafeteria for middle school in and upstairs from Ms. Issy and Ms. Ferrell's classrooms for high school.
- Water will be sold at breakfast and lunch if needed, and beverage machines will be located in hallway. The school will have bottled water available for emergencies.
- During class changes students will move from class to class staying to the right side of the hallways to eliminate congestion.
- Designated cafeteria seating will be established for each grade level.
- Nonessential visitors will be limited and seen by appointment only.
- Only essential vendors will be allowed on campus.

### Other Activities

- All students will gather in the chapel for Mass.
- Field trips will be determined on a case by case basis at the particular time.
- Clubs and after school activities will meet as scheduled.
- High school after school care will be available on all full school days. It will not be offered on PLC or early dismissal days.
- All athletic activities will follow the guidelines set forth by the Mississippi High School Activities Association.

## **Health and Sanitation**

- Classroom furniture will be limited to allow adequate spacing of desks.
- Students will use hand sanitizer when arriving and leaving each room.
- Desks will be sanitized between each class period.
- Shared items will be sanitized after each use.
- Teachers will maintain updated seating charts to allow contact tracing if needed.
- The custodial staff will sanitize common areas and restrooms throughout the day, and clean and sanitize the building at the end of each day.

## **Masks**

Masks will be required when social distancing cannot be adequately achieved indoors. We encourage all students 12 and older to obtain the vaccine. Please remember Sacred Heart is hosting a vaccination clinic on August 11. Click [here](#) to sign up.

## **Water Bottles**

Water fountains will not be available for use this year until the refillable water bottle stations have been installed. **Each student will be required to bring a filled water bottle to school each day.** Please label the bottle clearly with your child's first and last name. The school will have bottled water available for emergencies.
